Junior Dart Club Rules

- 1** All Parents of any junior player must be a member of the West Tradies Club Ltd and also a member of the Mt Druitt Dart Club Inc.
- 2** The annual subscription for membership of the Mt Druitt Junior Dart Club for each playing member shall be decided by a Executive Committee Meeting annually, and shall not be less than the \$5.00 membership providing that the Junior Member attends training sessions arranged by the Junior Committee
- 3** Any junior playing member who is not currently participating in Training sessions with the Mt Druitt Junior Dart Club during any financial year will remain a member of the Dart Club for the remaining portion of that financial year
- 4** Membership shall be from 1st January to 31st December of each year
- 5** The dart club reserves the right to refuse membership to any person and is within its rights not to give an explanation either verbally or in writing
- 6** All players must wear enclosed footwear while playing at any venue unless they have a current dated Doctors Certificate, Which a copy must be given to the Dart Club and shown on request
- 7** The executive committee must set down the amount of games fees to be paid by all Junior members at the start of the year and prior to the commencement of any Training sessions being played and shall not be less than \$4.00 per person per Training Session
- 8** This must be paid to the Junior Financial Manager before commencing training sessions
- 9** Any player any more than 2 weeks behind in fees shall be deemed un-financial and will not be allowed to play until all money is paid in full

10 Any Player who has outstanding monies for any reason will be deemed un-financial and will not be eligible to participate in any event including Championships arranged by the Dart Club

Junior Members

11 All Junior players must abide by the rules and regulations of the Mt Druitt Dart Club Inc, the NSW Junior Dart Council and the Darts Council Inc Constitutions

12 All junior parents or guardians are to be given copies of the following documentation
(1) Child Protection policy

13 All Junior dart players must be accompanied by at least (1) parent or relative at all times whilst on the premises of the West Tradies Club Ltd. If for any reason a parent or guardian cannot be present a letter is to be sent to the Junior Dart Club Committee stating who will be the carer for said junior and for what length of time the parent/guardian will be absent

14 Ages of players will be set up in 2 categories

- 1) Sub juniors are aged between 7 and 13 on their 13th Birthday they automatically progress to a Junior
- 2) Juniors are from 13 and can play through to the end of the year that they turn 18
- 3) At the coaches discretion a sub-junior may be up graded to a junior at any time

15 Uniforms of club shirts with black pants or skirt and black shoes must be worn whilst representing Mt Druitt Dart Club Inc at any events arranged by the Dart Club and State Events

16 No alcohol is to be consumed by junior players. Adults in control of junior players are not to participate in the consumption of alcohol in any part of the venue appointed as the playing area. Adults in control of Junior Players are not permitted to play poker machines while at any event arranged by the Dart Club. They are also not permitted to play poker machines while at State Events as per the NSW Junior Constitution

17 The chewing of Gum (of any description) is not permitted by junior players and Sub juniors at any State managed event nor at any event arranged by the Dart Club

18 Junior and Sub-junior Championships will comprise of Singles, Doubles and Mixed doubles

19 To be eligible to play in Championships Junior players must attend 50% of their training sessions prior to the Championships starting we will not accept Juniors only turning up for Championships when they have not attended any training sessions

- 20** Any Junior member who does not attend Training sessions for a period of four (4) weeks must notify the Administrator in WRITING ONLY of their intended absence which will specify when the said junior will be returning to training and the said junior will not participate in any events arranged by the Mt Druitt Senior or Junior dart clubs during the time of absence
- 21** A Championship will be held twice a year with both junior and senior players being able to participate under the condition that they are financial members of the Mt Druitt Dart Club Inc
- 22** All Child Protection Policies, Codes of Conduct and junior personnel information are the property of the Mt Druitt Dart Club Inc and cannot be transferred to any other Club or Sporting body without the direct permission of the Mt Druitt Dart Club Inc Executive Committee and any such approvals must be obtained in writing.
- 23** Any Junior member that ceases to play for the Mt Druitt Dart Club Inc and transfers to another club will need to have a clearance from the Mt Druitt Junior Dart Club Administrator. Once the junior player leaves any membership to State and the Club will be revoked
- 24** Any Junior participating in a Senior Competition will be done by Invitation ONLY and this will be approved by the Senior Executive Committee only
